Karakashian leads the organization's advocacy and communications to expose and document grave violations against Palestinian children. An expert in Middle East issues, he has accumulated 10 years of experience writing and reporting news about the region. He holds a law degree from the University of Nottingham and a master's degree from Columbia University School of Journalism.

Lubin is a life-long peace, justice, and disability rights activist who has led nearly twenty delegations of North Americans to Palestine/ Israel, Iraq, and Lebanon. Sahar Vardi, Israeli peace activist from Jerusalem, who has served three prison sentences for

her refusal to be conscripted into Israel's military. Since her release in 2009 she has worked with the Israeli Committee Against House Demolitions, Taayush, the Sheikh Jarrah Solidarity movement and most recently, The American Friends Service Committee. She cohosts a weekly radio program in Jerusalem discussing current affairs and community action.
